I am hopeful everyone has been inspired, uplifted and come to know a little more about the wonderful writers of the messages.

Personally, I have as well and had a fantastic "Quest" every week researching God's word, inspiration from so many books and writers, and discovering deeper parts of myself.

A final book in my covey is by Baba Ram Dass. My favorite book Be Here Now (1971) spoke to me greatly (and still does). His other books are Grist for the Mill (1977), How Can I Help? (1985), and Polishing the Mirror (2013).

So this "Quest" has ended. Perhaps I can share with you my ultimate "Quest" from time past. In my 20's & 30' I spend much time traveling throughout the world listing to very-very many spiritual teachers. It was the ultimate of an experience.
